AFIR Legislation Challenge

The Alternative Fuels Infrastructure Regulation (AFIR) is a comprehensive regulatory framework established by the European Union (EU) to foster the development and deployment of alternative fuels infrastructure, including EV charging stations, across its member states. This initiative aims to support the transition to greener mobility solutions, ensuring that all drivers have access to the necessary resources for their alternative fuel vehicles.

Charging Accessibility for All Drivers

To ensure that all EV drivers have convenient access to charging stations, the AFIR mandates that operators of public charging stations must support ad-hoc charging sessions without requiring prior user registration.

Essential Elements of AFIR



Universal Accessibility

Charging stations must be accessible to all users without requiring registration or a prior subscription to a specific service provider.



Ad-Hoc Payment Support

Stations must support ad-hoc payment methods, including credit/debit cards and contactless payments via smartphones and other devices. These ad-hoc payments should accept widely used payment instruments across the Union to ensure convenience, security, and compliance with EU standards.



Transparent Pricing

Real-time pricing information must be provided, ensuring transparency and non-discrimination for all users.



Did you know?

From 13 April 2024, all new publicly accessible recharging points must accept card payments. By 1 January 2027, all new and existing recharging points must comply with this requirement.
